

Haledon Free Public Library Internet Use Policy:

Haledon Free Public Library offers public access to the worldwide network of information resources known as the Internet. The Internet enables Haledon Free Public Library to provide information beyond the confines of its own collection, in keeping with its mission to develop services and collections which reflect the community's diverse needs for knowledge, ideas, recreational reading, education and practical information.

The Internet provides access to a wealth of information that is personally, professionally, and culturally enriching to individuals of all ages. Internet access to material of a controversial or mature nature, as well as to material that is not accurate, complete, or current is unavoidable.

The Library endorses the American Library Association Library Bill of Rights, and under those guidelines all library users will be provided equal access to resources.

Haledon Free Public Library does not censor or filter information on the Internet. Parents are expected to monitor and supervise their children's Internet sessions.

Viewing of certain materials in the public library may be considered improper in time, place or manner. The library reserves the right to end a computer usage session at any time.

As is true of other library materials and resources, any use of Haledon Free Public Library's Internet connection for illegal, inappropriate, or obscene purposes or in support of such activities is prohibited. Misuse or abuse of internet workstations, software, or the internet will result in suspension of internet access privileges.
